Sealed tender are invited for the supply of Veterinary Pharmocopial Medicine from **LICENSED VETERINARY PHARMOCOPIAL & DRESSING MATERIAL MANUFACTURES & REPACKERS** only by the Deputy Director Veterinary Services, Dhamtari Chhattisgarh,.

1. The tender must be submitted in sealed cover envelop and should reach to the office of the undersigned on or before **16 June 2011 up to 3.00 PM**. The committee will open the tender at **16 June 2011 at 4:00 P.M.** The tender can be submitted personally or by registered post A.D. The envelope shall bear the address of the tenderer and shall be super scribed with the words **"TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF VETERINARY PHARMOCOPIAL & DRESSING MATERIAL '**
2. The prices should be quoted inclusive of all taxes, packing forwarding insurance and freight charge F.O.R. Dhamtari. The time and limit for execution of such order shall be 60 days from the date of issue order. The tender must be accompanied with earnest money/ security deposit of 3% cost of tender item in the form of :-
 - (a) The Bank draft / F.D. of any scheduled Bank.
 - (b) Bank draft/ FD (Fix Deposit Receipt) be prepared in favour of the undersigned by designation.
 - (c) The depositor agrees in the writing to undertake any risk involved in the investment.
 - (d) The amount of EMD will be refunded to the unsuccessful competitors or rejection of their tender at their cost. It will be retained from the successful competitors as per term and conditions of the contract.
 - (e) Cash or Cheque will not to be accepted.
3. Each tender should be accompanied with the Signed and sealed agreement bond, Attested Photocopy of License, and copy of Sale/Commercial Tax Registration.
4. **THE TENDER WILL HOLD GOOD UP TO 31 March 2012.**
5. The D.D.V.S. reserves the right of the accepting the tender in whole lot or distinct part of it or the supply can be distributed between more than one tenderer.
6. The tenderer should tender in the enclosed form only. The same on acceptance will constitute the contract in terms specified there in.
7. The tender thus received will be opened on **16 June 2011** in the Office of Deputy Director, Veterinary Services, Dhamtari, Chhattisgarh, at **4.00 P.M.** by a committee appointed for the purpose of such Tenders or his/their authorized representative who choose to attend at the time of opening the tender in person.
8. No tender shall be taken into consideration unless it satisfies all the requirements prescribed above and is presented within prescribed time limit. Deputy Director, Veterinary Services, Dhamtari Chhattisgarh, however reserve the right to give any relaxation in this connection.
9. **The conditional tenders are liable to be rejected.**
10. The undersigned may reject all or any of the tenders without assigning any reasons there off.
11. A list showing the names of those persons, who are working with Veterinary Department C.G., should be appended with the tender.
12. In the event of tender being submitted by a firm it must be signed separately by each member and in the event of absence of many partner it must be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power of attorney authorizing him to do so which should be produced with the tender and it

must disclose that the firm is duly registered under the Indian Partnership Act and it should also specify the number of partners who constitute the firm.

13. NO PERSON OR FIRM IS PERMITTED TO SUBMIT MORE THAN ONE TENDER UNDER DIFFERENT NAMES.
14. The rates tendered shall not be altered by the tenderer during the terms of the contract.
15. Tenders shall be accompanied with sealed sample of items for which samples have been desired as stated in the appendix. The samples are submitted in sealed bag bearing complete address of the tenderer and description remain in deposit with the undersigned (till the duration of the contract). The samples of rejected tender will be returned only after such decision is taken at the cost of the tenderer. The tenderers will have to collect back their samples so deposited within 30 days from issue of letter to that after from this office. In case sample are not lifted back within 30 days then a sample will be forfeited and tenderer will have no right to claim for the same.
16. Each page of the Tender and its enclosures should be signed at the bottom by the tenderer.
17. The serial No. Of the articles referred in Appendix should be quoted in the tender for reference.
18. In case of spurious preparation the rates should be quoted inclusive of excise duties.
19. The undersigned of the department bears no liability for arranging import permits for the goods ordered by us.
20. All dues regarding taxes including sales tax, Octroi duties etc. levied on the supply shall be payable by the contractor himself. The department shall grant certificate for total quantity of supply made but shall not entertain any claim on this account.
21. The amount of Earnest money shall be refunded in full in case tender of the firm is totally rejected otherwise the amount of earnest money security deposit shall be adjusted against security deposit of equal to 3% of value order placed. However, in case the amount so deposited as found short to cover the full value of security deposit the contractor shall have to deposit the difference within **15 days** of the notice so issued by the undersigned under registered cover otherwise the contract shall stand terminated and security deposit would be forfeited.
22. Illegible and over writing cutting artifice etc. in the rates will make the tender liable for rejection.
23. The abstract information regarding tender be submitted duly signed by the tender.
24. If the rates quoted by the firm in tender documents i.e. proposed rates & M. R. P. rates, got any difference on product information slip at the time of supply then the same must be informed Deputy Director, Veterinary Services, Dhamtari Chhattisgarh, well in time (before supply). Regarding above term it is clarified that :-
 - (a) After approval of Tender rate, if M. R. P. increases, there will be no change in approved rates and tenderer have to supply the order on approved tender rates however.
 - (b) If M. R. P. decreases from approved tender rate then the rates will also decrease in same proportionate and the decreased rate will be treated as approved rate, Tenderer have to supply the medicines otherwise Deputy Director Veterinary Services has the right to take legal action.

Again if Deputy Director Veterinary Services came to know that there is a difference in the rate mentioned in tender documents and in supply goods. Then Deputy Director have the right to take appropriate action & difference amount will be deducted from security deposit. Tenderer are directed to inform the Authorized agent through which the Medicine will be supplied.

25. Market standing certificate, Good manufacturing certificate, Non conviction certificate issued by the Authority with at least three years continuous manufacturing license.
26. Manufacturing units should have minimum turnover of annual Rs. Fifty lakh during last financial year.
27. **TENDER EVALUATION: - The evaluation of the cover-A and B (Technical and Commercial bid) opened by the Tender opening Committee to provisionally assign the item-wise selection in the order of preference as under.**

29. Medicines & drugs shall be IP-BP standard quality only.
30. The expiry date of medicines must be of minimum one year from the date of supply.
31. This office will issue 'D' Form for C.S.T.
31. **The original drug license must be produces at the time of opening of technical bid before the tender committee.**

4. Manufacturing units should have minimum turnover of annual Rs. 50 Lakhs during last financial year.
5. Good manufacturing Practices certificate.

- 4- The set of tender document Technical Bid (Envelope A) , Financial Bid (Envelope B) and Envelope "C" dully completed in all respects shall be submitted in notice inviting tender in a sealed envelope so as to reach within time.**

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. The tenderer whose contract may be accepted (herein after called the contractor) shall within fifteen days of receipt of information of the acceptance of the tender by him, should deposit sum equal to 3% of the value of order placed with him, whichever is higher, either in cash or in any of the Government Treasury or furnish approved Government securities for this amount duly endorsed to the Deputy Director Veterinary Services, Dhamtari C.G. The amount may also be deposited in any other manner accepted to the Deputy Director in terms of general orders of Government issued from time to time. All damages or to be born by the contractor otherwise sum of money payable by the contractor to the Governor of Chhattisgarh under the terms of this contract, may be deducted from the amount of security deposit after the proper completion of the contract.
2. The prices will hold good for end of 31 March 2012. The delivery of goods by the contractor should be at Deputy Director Veterinary Services, Dhamtari. The cost of packing, forwarding, freight and other charges for effecting delivery at the destinations shall be borne by the contractor.
3. The Deputy Director Veterinary Services, Dhamtari C.G. reserves the right to increase or decrease any one or more items of supply during the contract. The contractor will be bound to comply without any claim for the compensation.
4. All dues regarding taxes and duties including sales tax commercial tax, excise duty, octroi duties levied on the supply shall be payable by the contractor himself. The Department shall grant a certificate of total quantity of supply made but not entertain any claim on this account.
5. All losses during transit due to breakage and shortage, spoilage etc. will have to be born by the contractor at his own cost.
6. The contractor shall not sublet the contract assigned to any other party or parties, the whole or any portion of the contract.
7. In case commodities indented are not supplied within the time limit or loss is not made good according to the terms & conditions of this contract, the tenderer shall be liable to pay liquidated damages and by the way of penalty the sum of 2% of the cost of order placed, shall be deducted from bill. Further it shall be lawful for the Deputy Director Veterinary Services, Dhamtari C.G. to purchase the articles indented from open market at the risk and cost of the contractor who in addition to the liquidated damages, aforesaid shall also be liable for any losses or damages caused by the said purchases to the Governor. In case, however, no supply is made even after expiry of **60 days** from the issue of order of supply before closing of financial year, the amount of security deposit shall be forfeited to the Government of Chhattisgarh and the contract shall stand terminated. However, if the Deputy Director is satisfied that the delay in supply was caused by the circumstances beyond the control of contractor, he may grant him in writing, extension of time which will not exceed **90 days** in case. In such case the Head of the Department may forgo the whole or part of the liquidated damages as the Deputy Director may deem proper except the actual extra cost incurred in making purchases from open market.
8. **THE RATES WHICH ARE QUOTED WILL REMAIN VALID UP TO 31 MARCH 2012.**
9. In the event of the supply being not accepted at the destination, it shall be responsibility of the contractor to remove the same forthwith at his own charges and cost.
10. In the event of breach of the terms & conditions of the contract by the contractor, the Deputy Director, shall forfeit the security deposit of the balance there as that may at that time be remaining, for the said breach, but without prejudice to the right of Governor of Chhattisgarh

to recover further sum as damages from any sum which may become due to the contractor by the Government or otherwise however.

11. Any amount due to the Governor of Chhattisgarh from the contractor on any account in respect of this tender may be recovered from him at arrears of land revenue.
12. In case of any dispute arising out of this contract or any of the provisions herein contained or anything arising here out except in respect of matters on which the decision of the Deputy Director Veterinary Services, Dhamtari C.G. is herein before declared to be final and binding to all. The same shall be referred to the Secretary (Agriculture), Government of Chhattisgarh, Raipur for arbitration and his decision thereon shall be final and binding on all concerned.
13. Dispute in arbitration and complaint should be lodged in Dhamtari court only.
14. **The original drug license must be produces at the time of opening of technical bid before the tender committee.**
15. **In comparison of rates between tenderer of state and tenderer of other states, commercial tax should be subtracted from rates of tenderer of Chhattisgarh registered under commercial tax Act.**
